

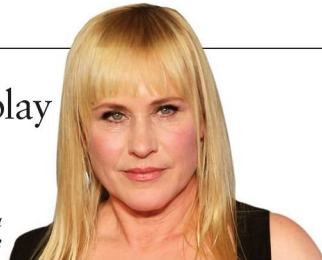

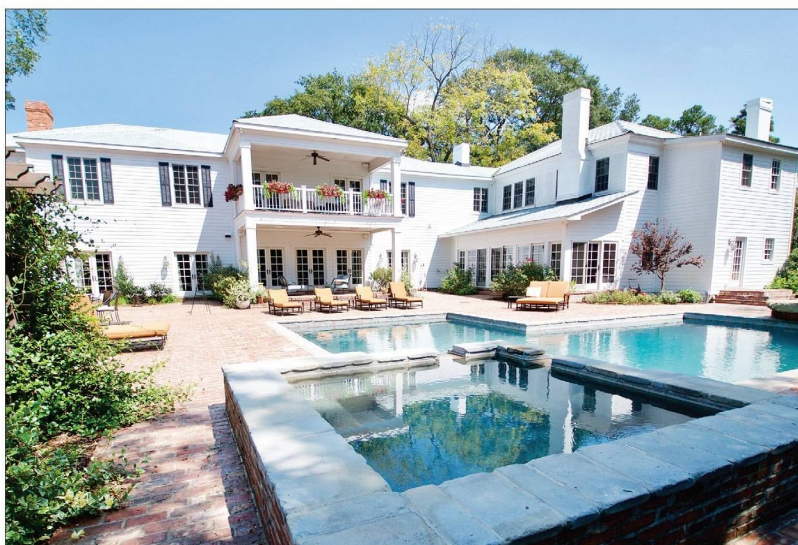
This week: Homes for equestrians

1 ► Tiverton, R.I. Summer Field's Farm is set on 3.9 acres of verdant fields bordered by historic stone walls. The four-bedroom shingle-style house has floor-to-ceiling windows, a chef's kitchen, and a great room with a local-fieldstone fireplace and a balcony. The four-stall, metal-roofed barn with paddock stands on a hillside with mature trees and expansive views of the Sapowet salt marsh. \$2,195,000. 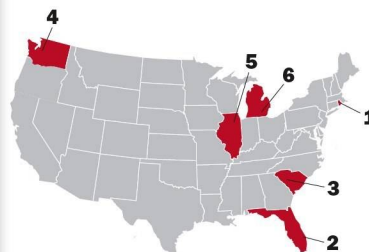
2 ► Wellington, Fla. This almost-5-acre horse farm includes a nine-stall barn, a 210-by-120-foot sand ring, five paddocks, a feed room, and a tack room. The five-bedroom house has an open-floor plan, a kitchen with professional appliances, wood trim throughout, and oversized windows. Outside are a salt-water pool surrounded by palm trees, a Chicago-brick patio, an outdoor kitchen, and a remote audio, climate, and light system. \$3,650,000. 3 ► Ridge Spring, S.C. The 1835 Boatwright Plantation, a 31.6-acre horse farm, includes an expanded six-bedroom antebellum home. The house features a gourmet kitchen, a billiards parlor, a theater room, a gym, integrated audio systems, and, outside, three balconies, an outdoor kitchen, and a pool. 4 ▲ Cle Elum, Wash. Teanaway Valley Farm sits on 71 acres 90 minutes from Seattle. The three-bedroom main residence with exposed-wood interior is built over the horse facilities. The property has three wells, 70 miles of irrigation, river rights, three barns, a commercial outdoor kitchen, a three-bedroom log home, and two bunkhouses. \$4,300,000. 5 ◀ Oswego, Ill. Occupying 17.9 acres, this 58-stall horse facility includes a riding arena, 14 paddocks, and 10 horse pastures. There are also an indoor lap pool, a gym, a large patio with outdoor fireplace for entertaining, and separate guest and staff quarters. \$3,200,000.
