

Warning: This Just-Listed Charleston Plantation Might Cause Swooning

What Thomas Hall Plantation lacks in history, it makes up for in stunning design.

Situated on roughly 125 acres just 13 miles from downtown Charleston, this gorgeous Johns Island estate will have you seeing hearts the moment you pass through its iron gates and then again as you set your eyes on the home at the end of a dramatic circle drive.

The 7,300-square-foot main house is flanked by towering oaks draped with Spanish moss and enjoys access to scenic Rantowles Creek. Built in

2014, the spacious six-bedroom, six-bathroom home boasts an airy open floorplan and impeccable attention to detail – not to mention sweeping views of the ancient rice fields out back. Adjacent to the house is a large outdoor pavilion and wedding-worthy entertaining space equipped with a full kitchen and fireplace overlooking a private fishing pond.

Trust us, if we had 6.9 million to part with, we'd snatch up this lowcountry stunner in an instant.

Historically, Thomas Hall was a part of the greater Savannah Plantation, until it was purchased by John Bulow and renamed Bulow Plantation in 1818. The Plantation was used for a wide variety of agricultural and mining activities throughout the 1700 and 1800s. The current owners purchased the plantation in 2003 and spent 15 years crafting the current landscape.
